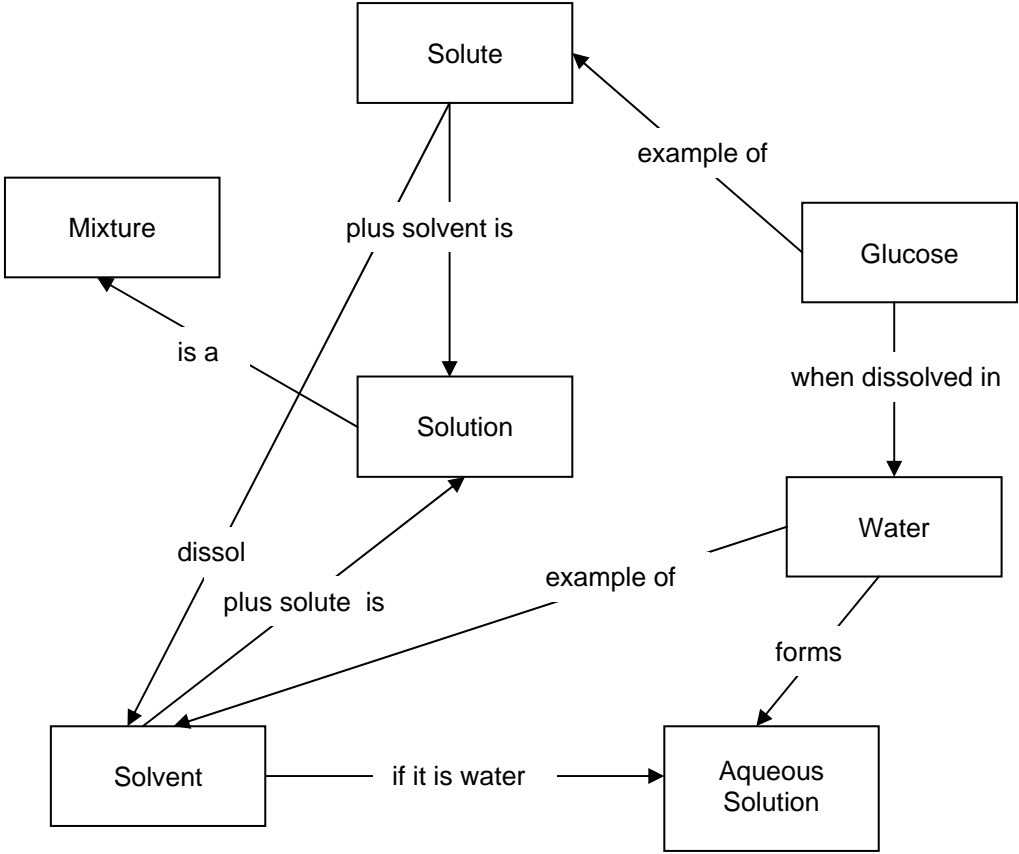


Concept Map – The concept map is used to show connections among complex ideas (e.g., democracy) or branching procedures (e.g., the circulatory system). Key questions to ask when working with this are: What is the superordinate category? What are the subordinate categories? How are they related? How many levels are there?
